Sunday

Creative Crafts – Grades 3,4 (Miss Michelle)

Creative Crafts is a club where it helps students become confident young artists by enhancing their skills. We will have great fun trying out different materials such as clay, charcoal and oil pastels. It is a fantastic club to join if you love to paint, draw and decorate various useable crafts whether for yourself or as gifts!

Dance/Gymnastics Club – Grades 1,2,3 (Miss Nicole/Miss Hanna)

An energetic and fun club where you can practice your gymnastic skills and become more flexible whilst creating fun dance routines to a variety of music. All abilities welcome – Let's have some fun!

Ball Games – Grades 1,2,3 (Miss Claire)

In ball games club, Children will develop their ball and team work skills playing ball games such as: Football, basketball, dodgeball and bench ball. A good fun club for Grades 1-3 where they can learn new games and have lots of fun.

Reading Comprehension – Grade 6 Girls (Miss Olivia)

The girls will be given the opportunity to explore a range of reading comprehensions so as to further develop their competency in this subject.

They will have the opportunity to work in groups, with a partner and independently and will be taught various skills and strategies so as to allow them to answer a range of questions with confidence.

Reading comprehension and storytelling – Grades 2,3,4 (Miss Robyn)

If you enjoy stories and reading, then come along to after school club. There will be a range of fiction and non-fiction texts for the children to look at as well as resources to help them read. The club will focus on reading comprehension skills including inference and deduction. They will also be given the opportunity to read, retell and act out stories to help with writing skills.

Problem Solving – Grades 3,4 (Miss Anne)

In this club, children will do maths problems each week that will be challenging and interesting. The teacher will help you if you get stuck and show you new strategies for solving problems more efficiently. All children will be encouraged to think deeply about



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mathematical concepts. You will be able to enjoy solving problems with other children who love maths.

Applique Craft – Grades 4,5&6 (Miss Jane)

The children will design a picture, either on their own or as a group. They will then use felt and other fabric to cut out the different images in their picture and sew them onto their chosen background.

Tag Rugby – Grades 3,4 girls (Miss Melissa/Miss Rhiannon)

Tag rugby is a non-contact, fun, team game where you carry an egg shaped ball past defenders to score a try on the ground. We will play lots of fun games that will help you learn how to play tag rugby and prepare you to play a game at the end. The tag rugby sessions will help to develop communication and team work.

Monday

Play Dough & Lego Club- Grades 1,2,3 (Miss Liz)

The club will involve using lego/playdough/ boxes/ clay to create models. Each week will be a different theme (buildings/people/animals/ robots/ vehicles/boats/ and free modelling activities to promote their creative side 😊

Art and Craft – Grades 1,2&3 (Miss Amrit)

Tuesday

Puppet making – Grades 1,2 (Miss Michelle)

Each week we will make different kinds of puppets together. We will make glove, sock, stick and shadow puppets. All resources will be provided as well as instructions on how to make the puppet. It will be a fun filled, busy club perfect for children who want to develop their creative skills.



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Design Club – Grades 1,2 (Miss Anelyn/Miss Josephine)

Children will be taught the skills to become independent designers. Each week they will work on a different art project developing their independence, creative and fine motor skills. Children will be able to take their creation home each week and will develop the skills needed to recreate their ideas with their friends.

Dodgeball/ball games – Grades 3,4 (Ms Gill)

In Dodgeball/ ball games club learners will improve their ball handling skills while developing team work skills and fair play attitudes.

Football – Grades 3,4 (Mr Sean)

The club will develop on the close ball control of the footballers, looking at trapping, turning, shooting and heading in particular. The footballers will further enhance knowledge and application of positional awareness, tactics and teamwork skills in real game situations.

Science Innovation- Grades 2,3,4

Cooking Club – Grades 1,2,3,4 (Miss Supriya/Miss Tate)
