Research a popular ancient Roman recipe and try to cook it at home with the help of an adult. Write the recipe or take photos.

#### Story

Write a story about a Roman. Think about how to describe the setting and character.

#### iMovie

Make an iMovie explaining different things about ancient Rome. E.g. buildings, roads, famous people, battles

#### Draw artefacts

Look at ancient artefacts e.g. helmet or sword and draw it using just a pencil and shading. Write what it was used for.

#### Create a comic strip

Think about a day in the life of a Roman. Create a short comic strip with a Roman character and draw what he would do in a day.

#### Maths questions

Write some addition and subtraction questions using Roman Numerals.

#### Draw the Roman armour

Research what Roman soldier's used to wear to protect them in battle and draw a soldier. Label the different armour.

#### Time line

Research 5 important dates and write them on a timeline in the correct order.

#### Poster

Research about the city of Rome. Make a poster with at least 3 facts.
