Write the recipe or take photos.</p>
<p><b>Make a catapult</b> Use old resources at home (like bottles and cereal boxes) to create your own Roman catapult.</p>	<p><b>Story</b> Write a story about a Roman. Think about how to describe the setting and character.</p>	<p><b>iMovie</b> Make an iMovie explaining different things about ancient Rome. E.g. buildings, roads, famous people, battles</p>
<p><b>Draw artefacts</b> Look at ancient artefacts e.g. helmet or sword and draw it using just a pencil and shading. <p><b>Draw the Roman armour</b> Research what Roman soldier's used to wear to protect them in battle and draw a soldier. Label the different armour.</p>	<p><b>Time line</b> Research 5 important dates and write them on a timeline in the correct order.</p>	<p><b>Poster</b> Research about the city of Rome. Make a poster with at least 3 facts.</p>
